The Lenawee Department On Aging annual picnic is being held at the fairgrounds today. Cari Rebottaro sent an invitation for the Committee members to stop by after the meeting.

Martha Hall provided highlights from the Health Department. She indicated that the partnership with WIC is going well. She said that Hepatitis A is increasing in the State of Michigan, however Lenawee County has not seen any additional cases. They are doing well with their outreach and have provided vaccines to 97 jail inmates and 39 deputies. They have also immunized several people in the homeless shelters and food service workers. The Wear One campaign has been very well received with 36 businesses offering free distribution of condoms. Well and septic permits are up which is typical for this time of year. Everything went well at MIS this year. The Tobacco Compliance checks were very disappointing with several businesses selling to decoys. Martha also stated that she chairs a task force that is going to start addressing ways to combat the Opioid problem in the County.

**Other reports:** Minutes from the LDA Board, Human Services Collaborative, and the Region 2 Area Agency on Aging were included in the meeting packet.
