## MINUTES: Wednesday, September 12, 2018 –11:00 a.m.

### I. Approval of Minutes – August 8, 2018

### II. Department Highlights

**A. Department on Aging:** The Department on Aging has their Adult Services Week coming up September 17-21 and their annual staff meeting will be on September 20<sup>th</sup>. The Lifestyle Expo went very well with over 40 vendors participating.

**B. Health Department:** The Health Department is collecting loose change to bring awareness to Alzheimers and hopes to have more people participate in next year's walk. They are trying to get their health educators to local events to provide general health information. Martha also reported that Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) testing for PFAS in Lenawee is well underway with approximately 75% of the testing completed. Results are starting to come in and thus far there have been no problems.

**C. Other reports:** Minutes from the Region 2 Area Agency on Aging and a list of human service related coalitions, workgroups, and committees was distributed.
