

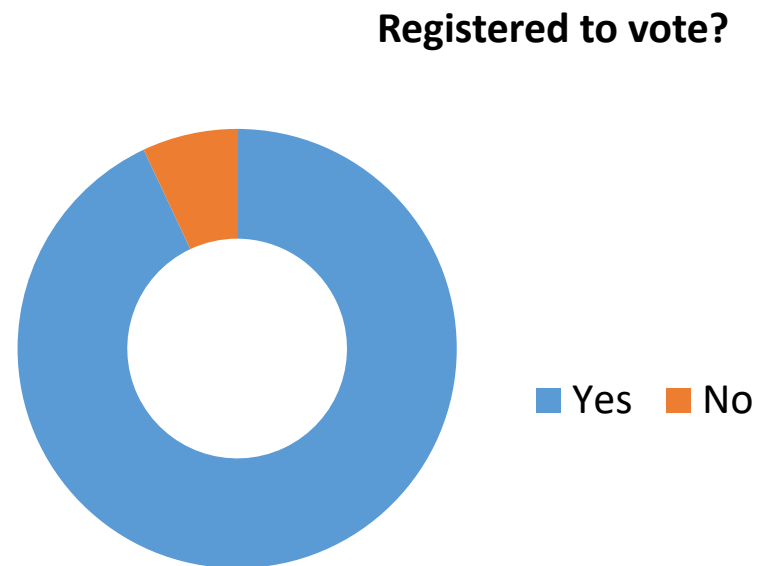


# 2018 Lenawee County Survey Results

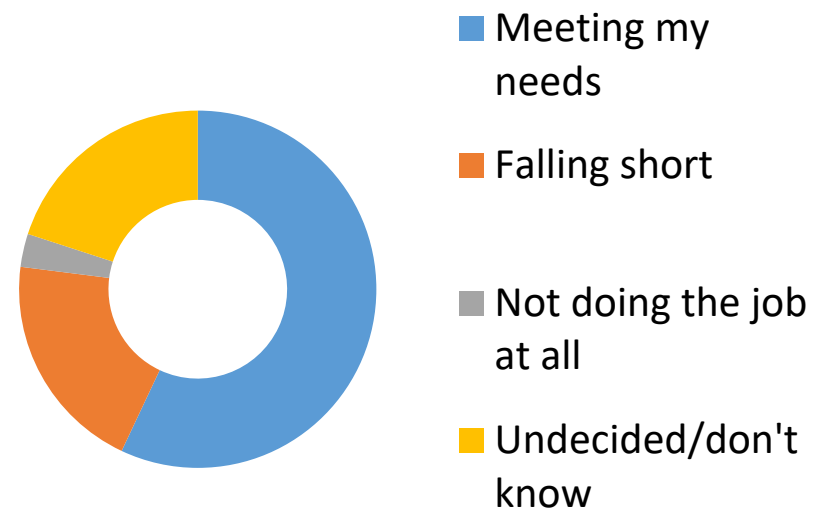


When you think about the services provided by Lenawee County government, are those services meeting your needs, falling short or not doing the job at all?

If the services are NOT DOING THE JOB AT ALL, what is the single most important need not being met? (This is the responses of the 3%)

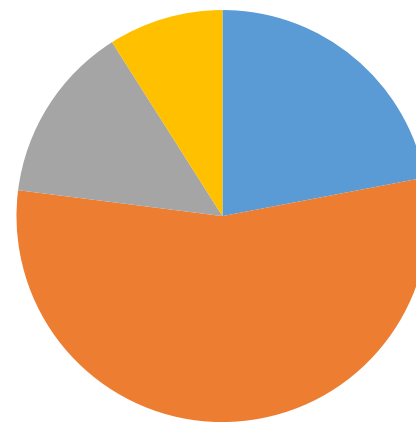
• **2B. Of the needs NOT being met, roads were cited as number one.**

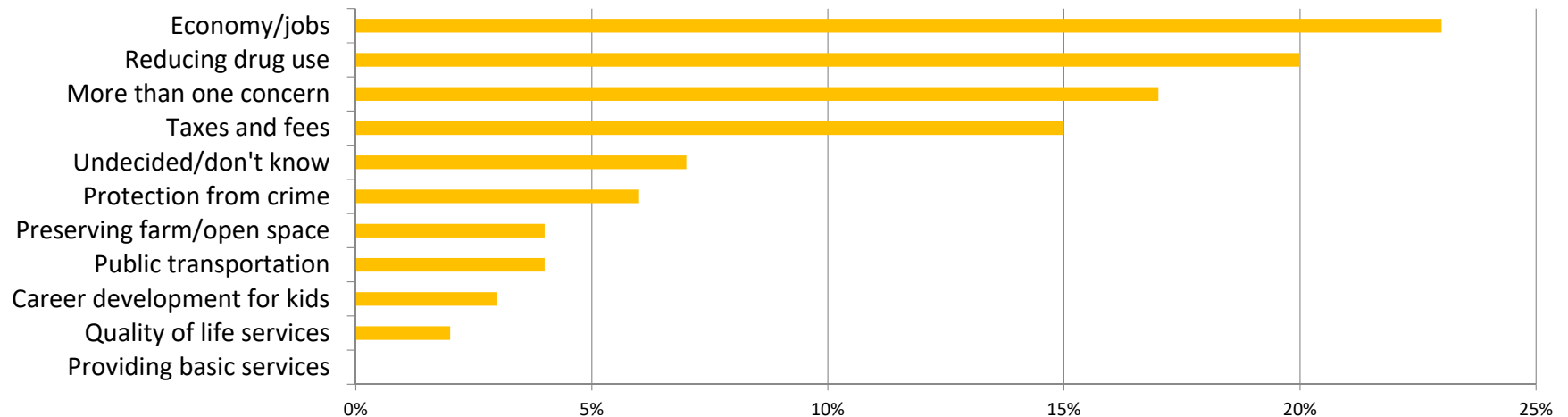

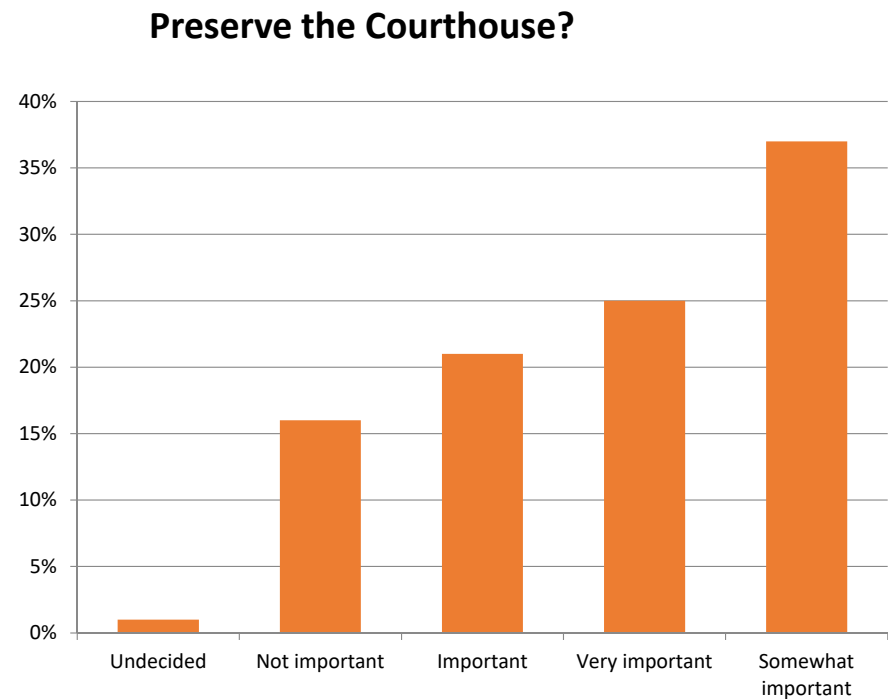




How important is it to you that the Historic Courthouse at 301 N. Main Street in Adrian remains a landmark, historical building and seat of County government?

- **6. Most respondents say it's important to preserve the Historic Courthouse as a seat of government and as a landmark.**

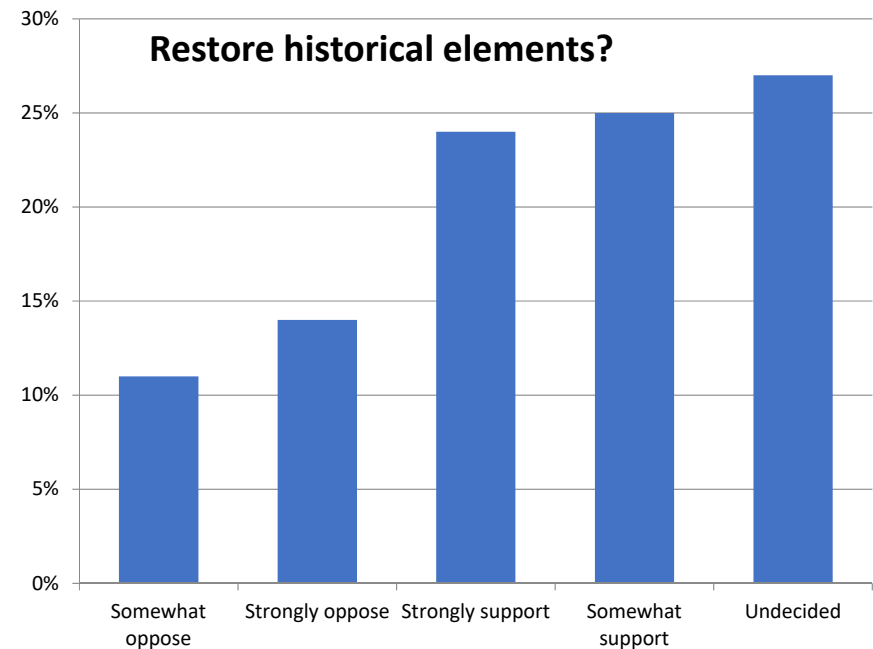

- **7. A combined majority strongly or somewhat supports restoring historical elements to the Courthouse; about a third are undecided.**

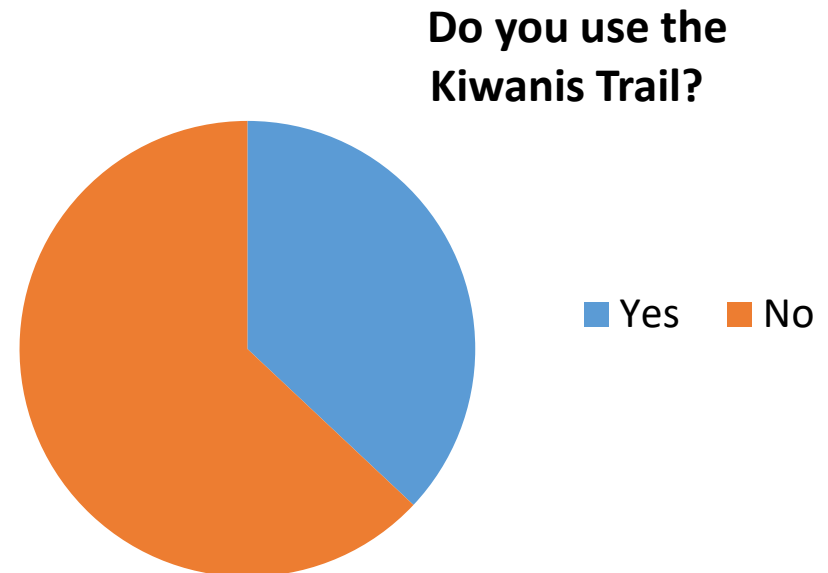

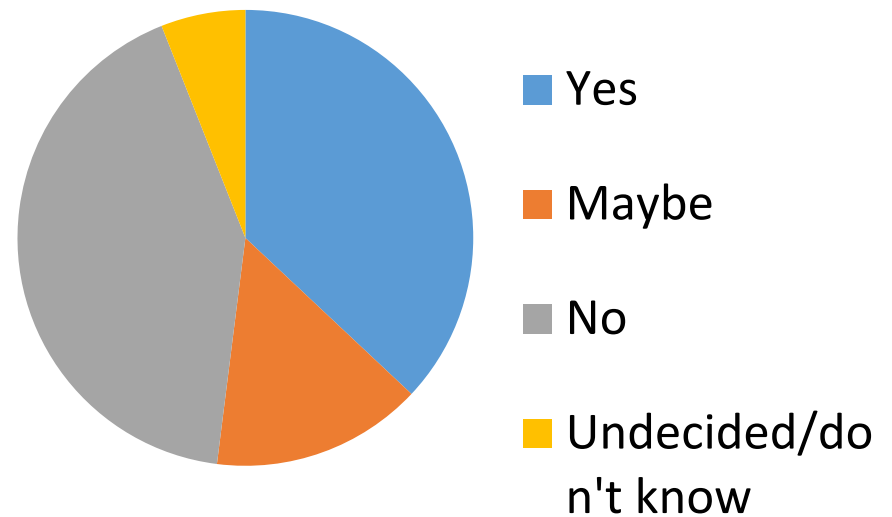


The Kiwanis Trail is being extended to Cal Zorn Park in the City of Tecumseh. Would you use the trail when it is completed?

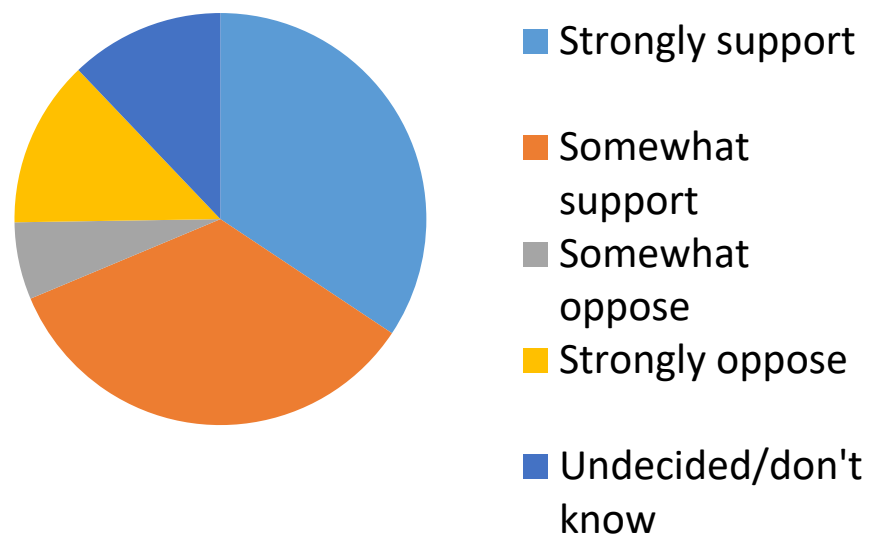


## Would you support or oppose an expanded trail system in Lenawee County that connects multiple communities?

Trail system connecting communities?

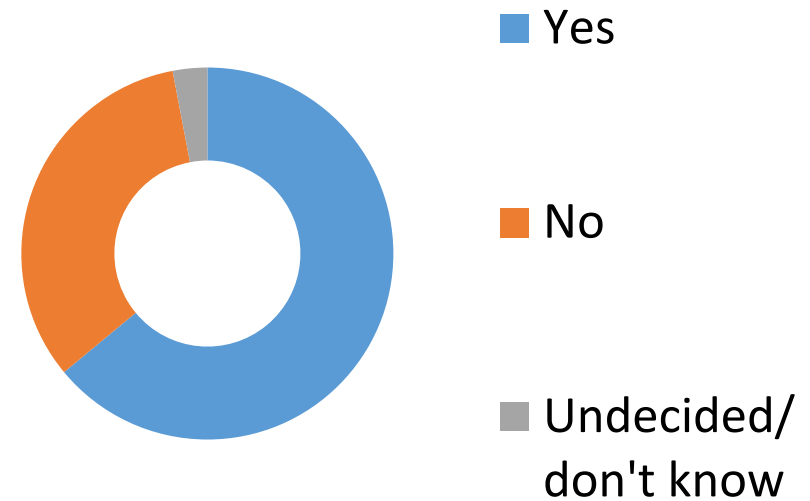


# In the last year, have you ever used any of the Lenawee County parks?

- **11. Most respondents say they have been to a County park.**

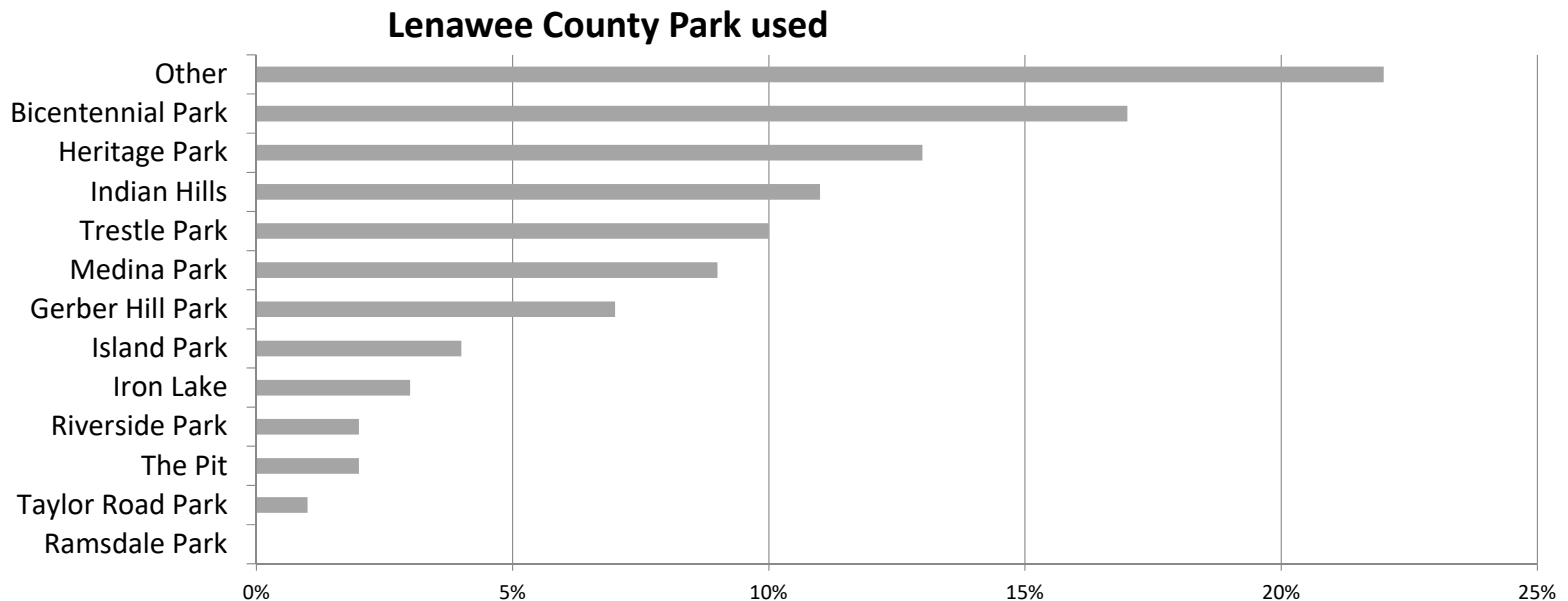

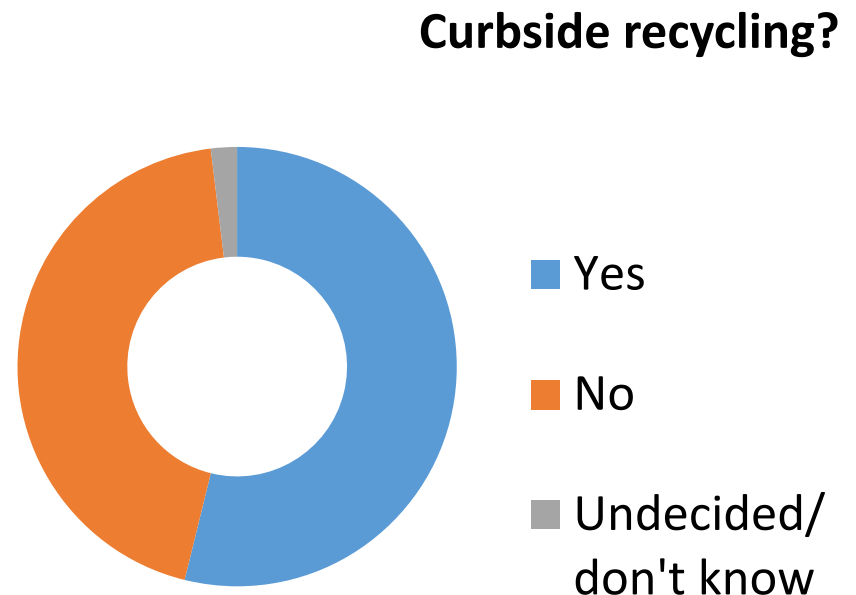

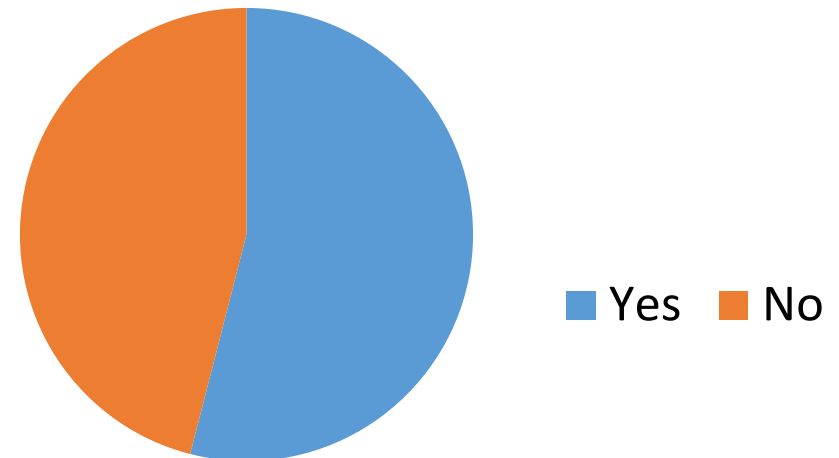

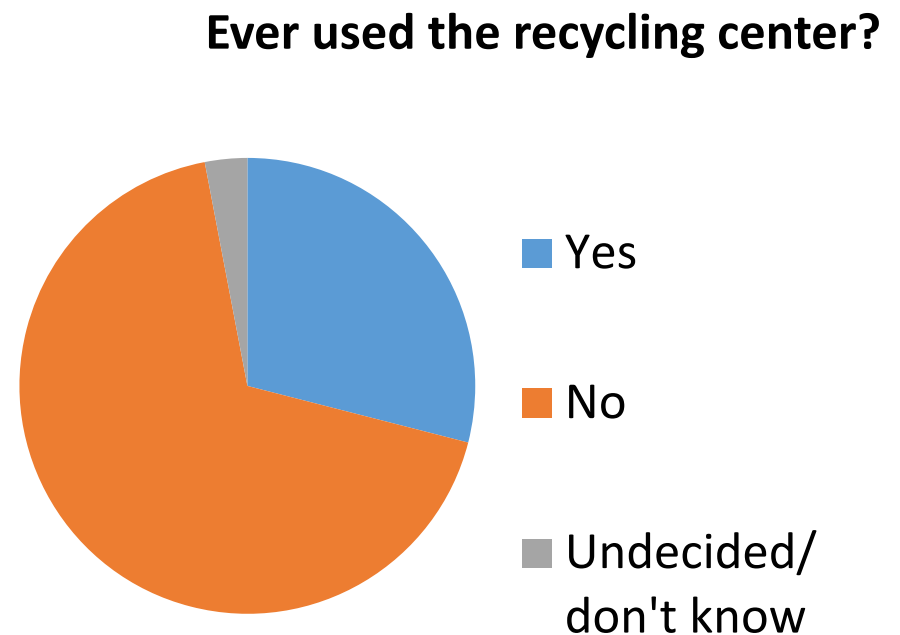

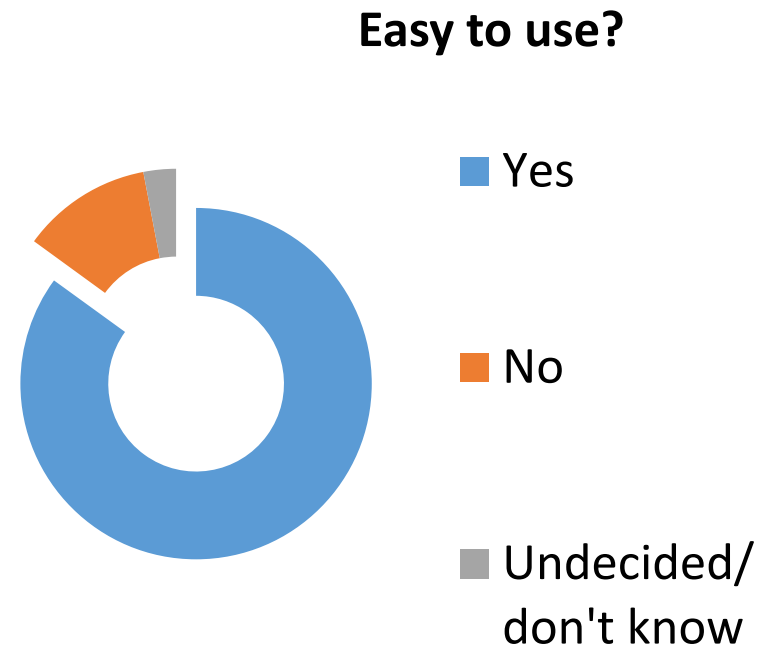

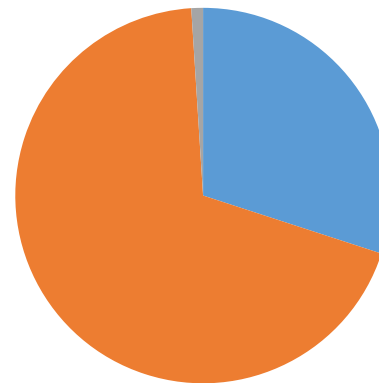

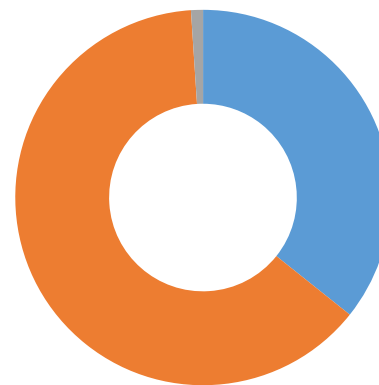

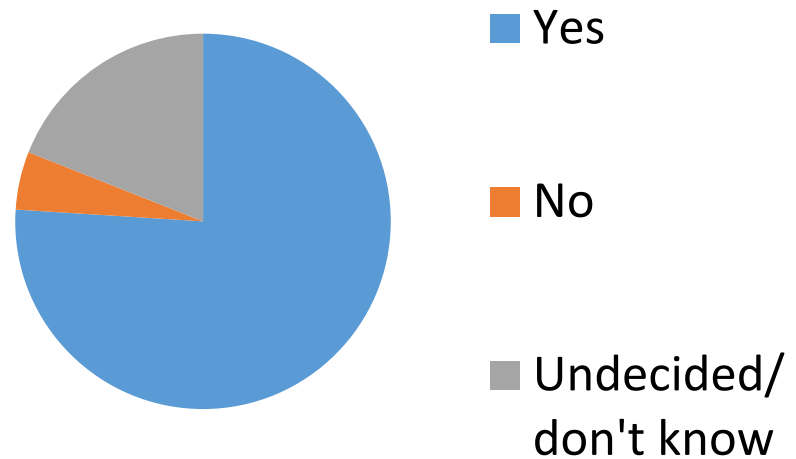

- **17. A solid majority says addiction is a problem in Lenawee County**

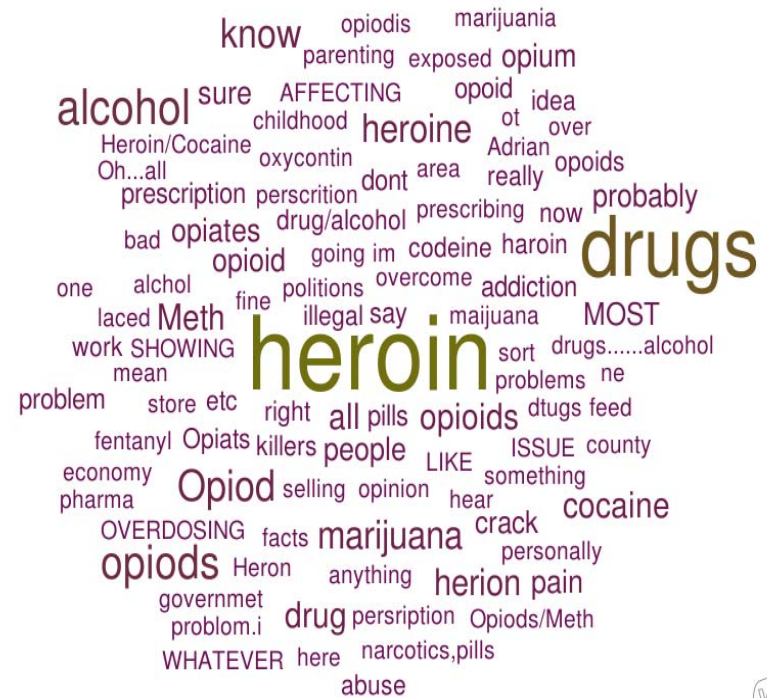

Does Lenawee have an addiction problem?



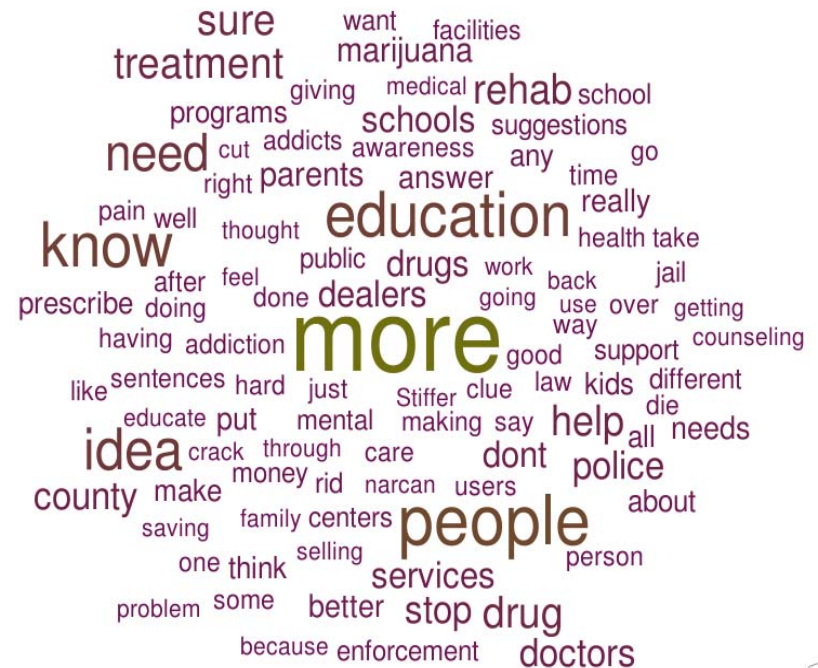
# Which addiction do you believe causes the most problems?

- **17B. Many suggest the problem could be addressed through more education, treatment and rehab**

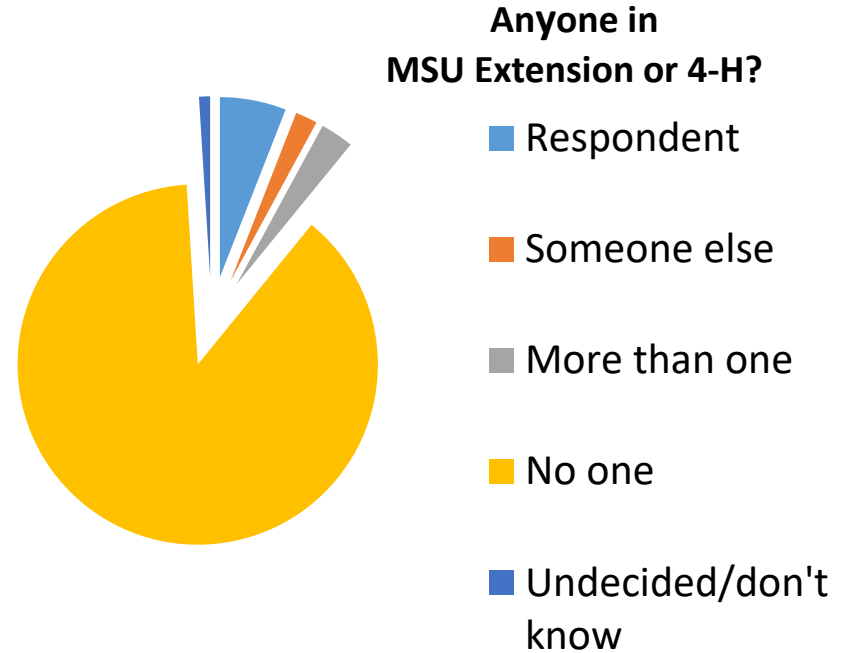




# Are you or a family member involved in any programs offered by MSU Extension?

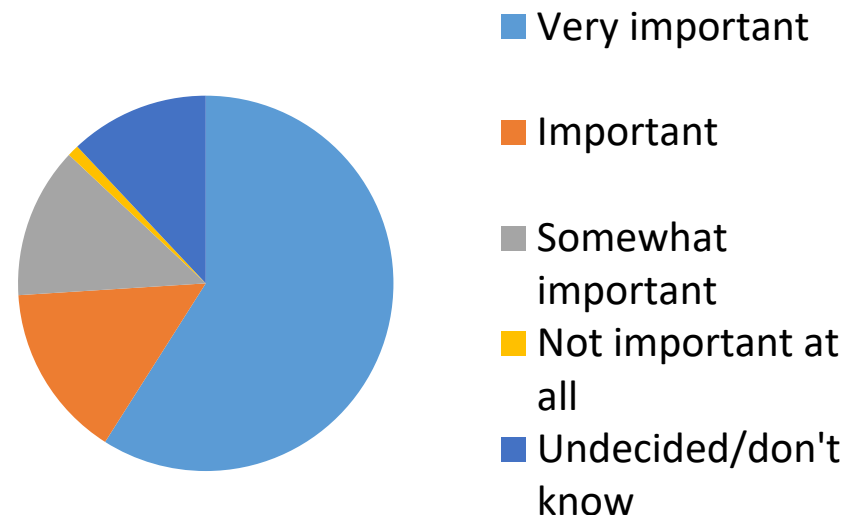


# How important are the MSU Extension and 4-H programs to the County?

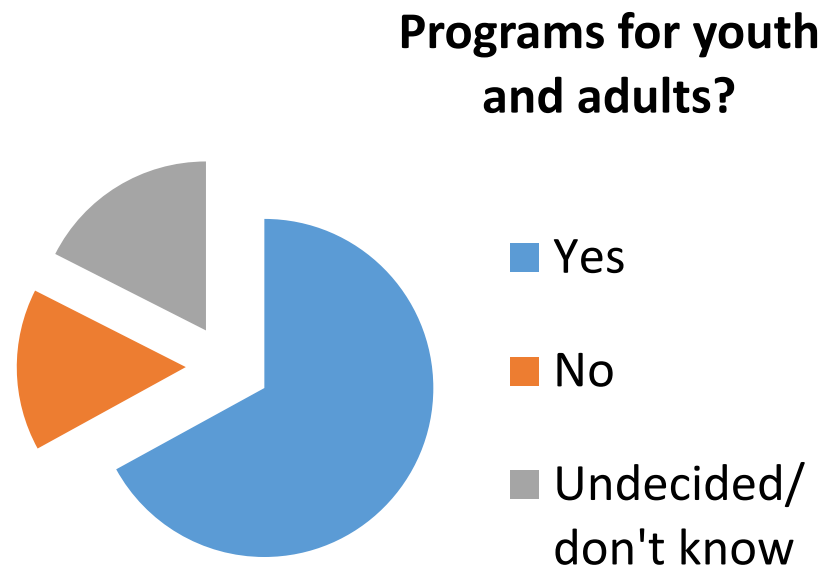

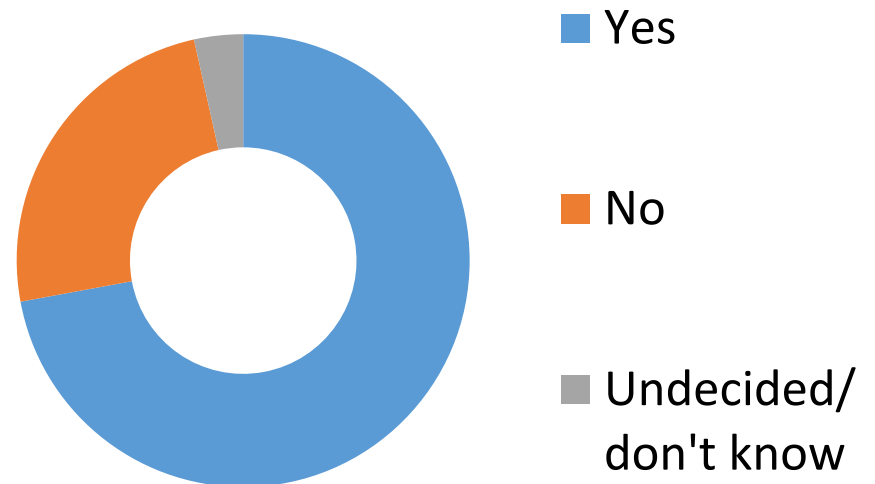

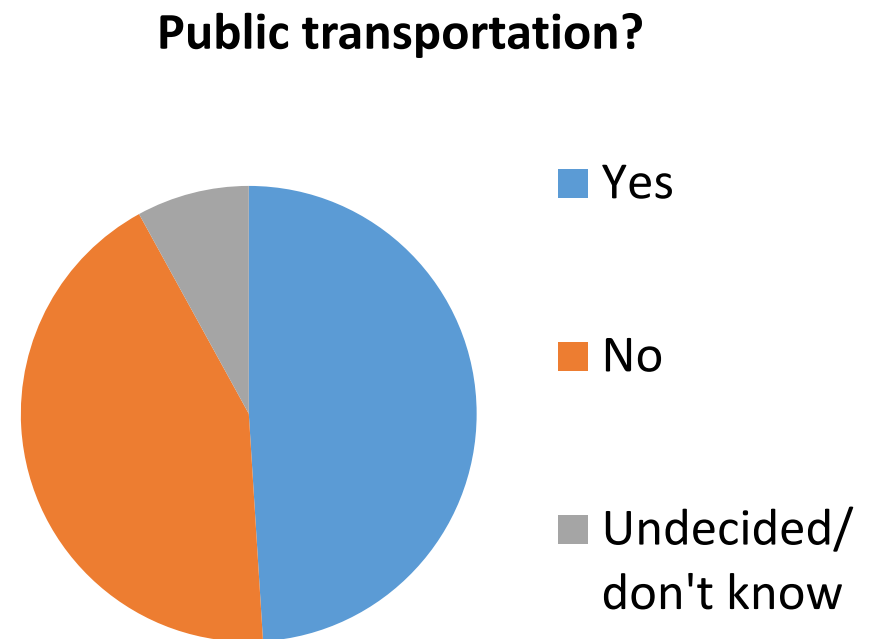

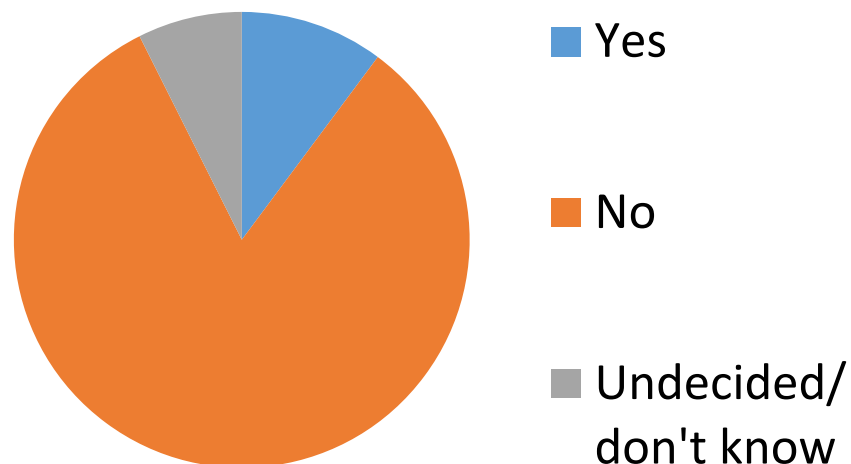

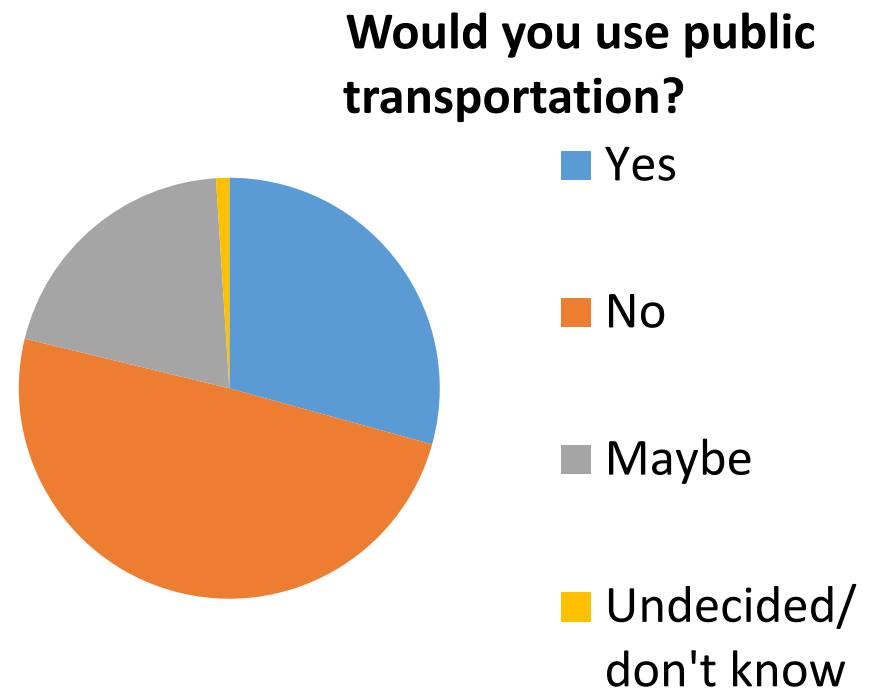
Do you use public transportation?



# If public transportation were available in your area would you use it?

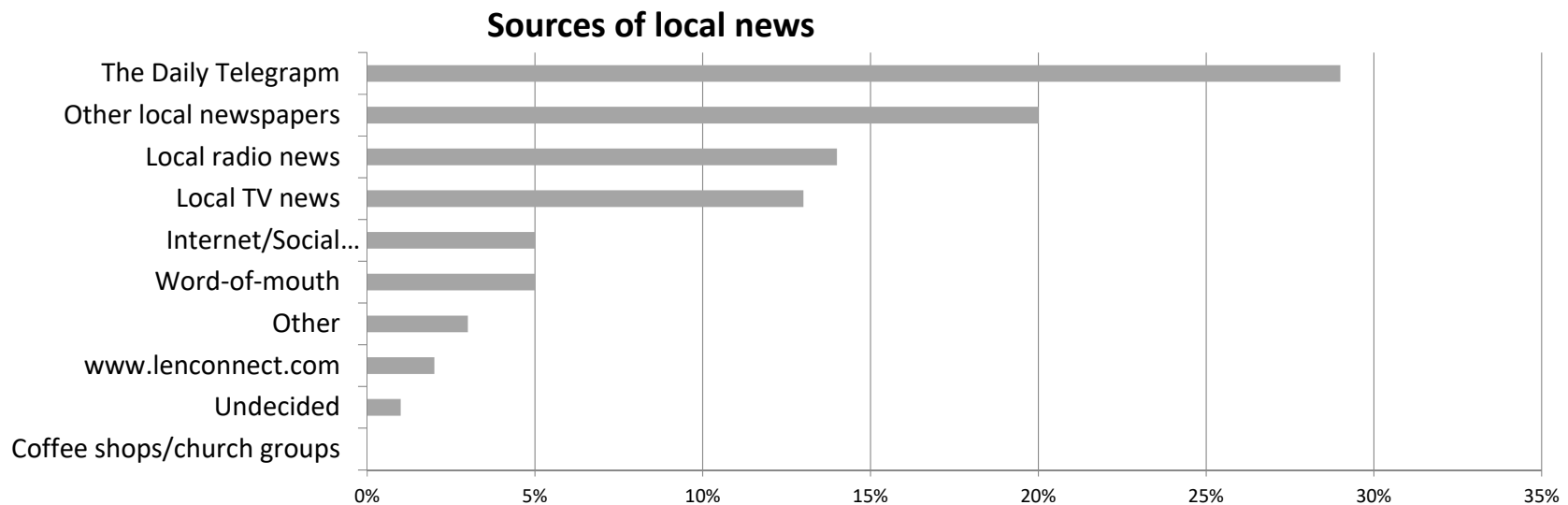
- **23. About half say they wouldn't use public transportation even it were available; the other half said yes or maybe.**

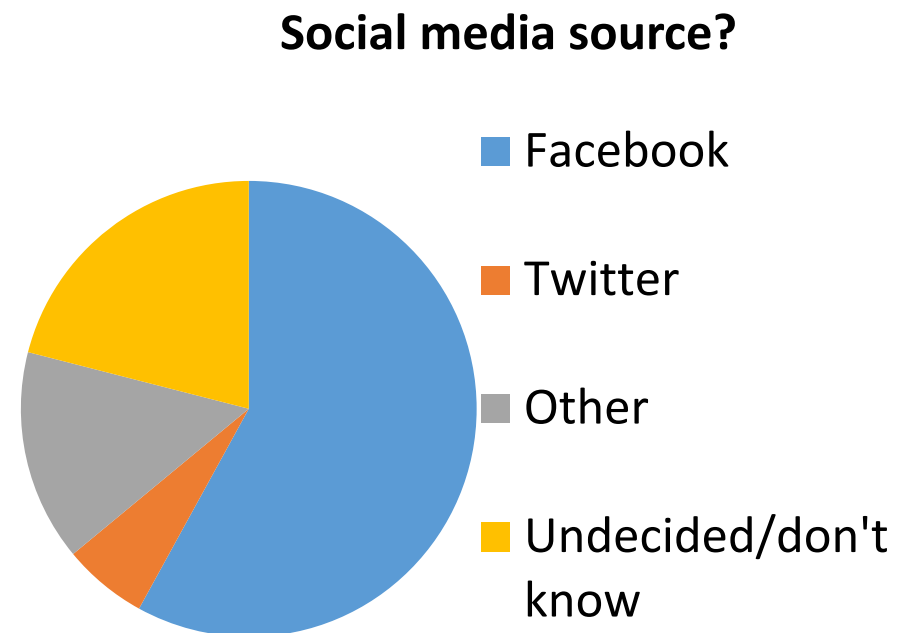

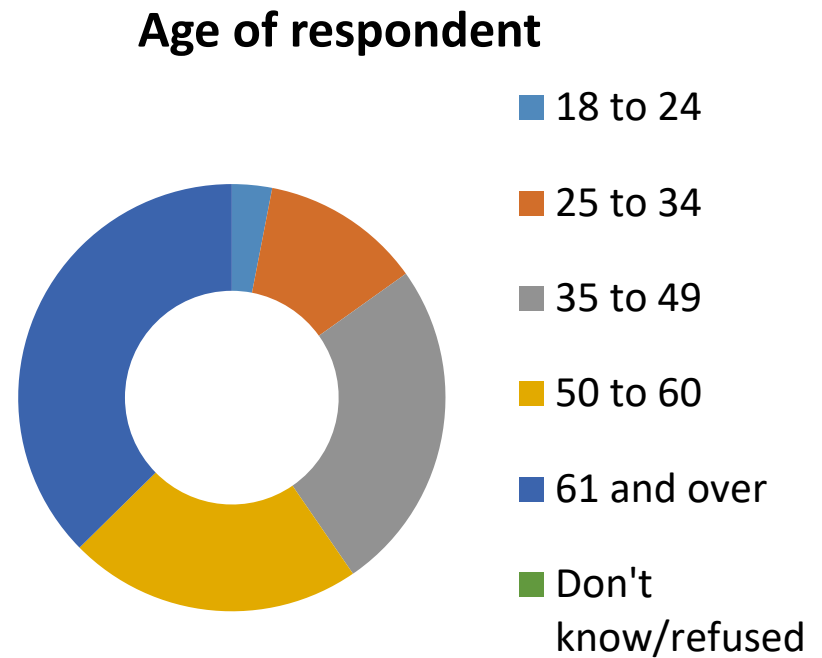

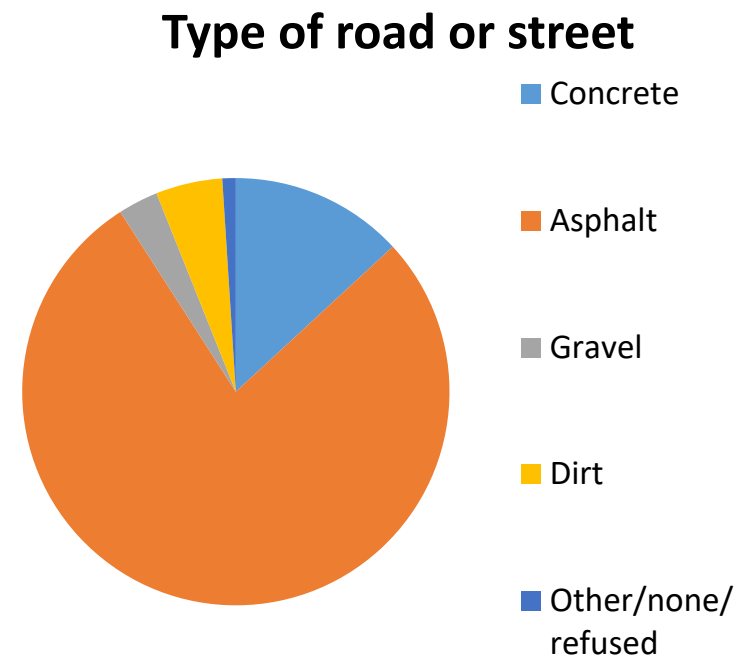

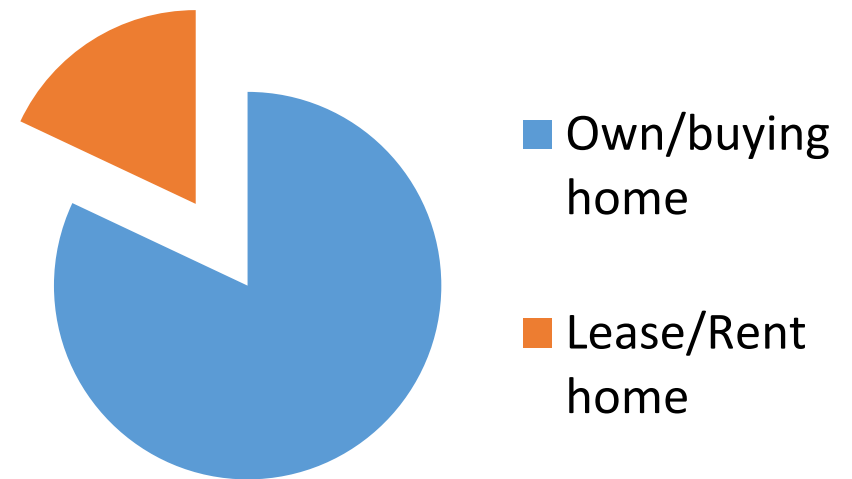

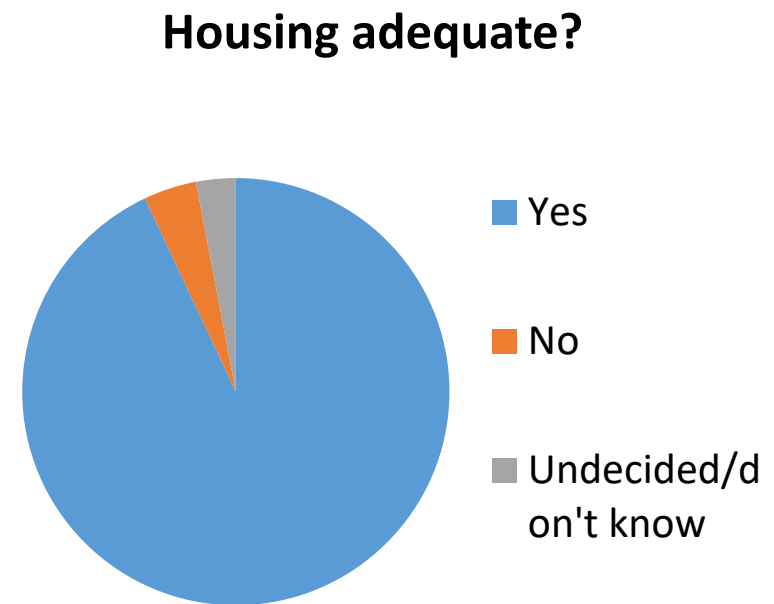

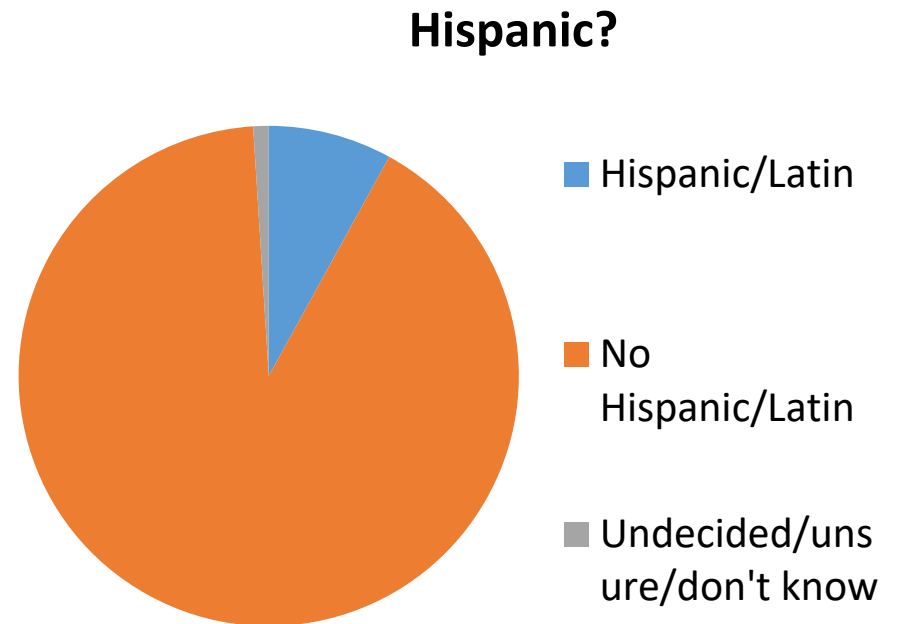
