FINAL ORDER OF DETERMINATION

WHEREAS, on October 4, 2011, Stephen R. May, Drain Commissioner of the County of Lenawee, State of Michigan, received for filing an Order of Necessity, issued by the Board of Determination, determining that it was necessary and conducive to the public health, convenience or welfare and that the Drain known as the "Hansen Tile" as indicated in the petition for cleaning out, relocating, widening, deepening, straightening, tiling, extending or relocating along a highway of the said Drain, located and established in the Township of Ridgeway, in the County of Lenawee, State of Michigan.

WHEREAS, On October 4, 2011 Stephen R. May, as Drain Commissioner, issued the Notifications of Municipalities; and,

WHEREAS, On October 27, 2011, Stephen R. May, as Drain Commissioner, issued the First Order of Determination.

The route and course of the drain is described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the North bank of Packard Joint County Drain located in the S 1/2 OF NE 1/4 OF SE 1/4 North of Railroad Section 1, T-6-S, R-5-E, Ridgeway Township Lenawee County Michigan thence across Section 1, across Section 2 through Downing Highway, across Section 2 according to survey by J.L. Richard dated June 15, 1910 and in accordance with maps and records on file at the Office of the Lenawee County Drain Commissioner.

WHEREAS, Since the date of the Order of Necessity, survey and measurements of the Drain has been made and found to be practicable and the rights of way for the drain and all damages by reason of the construction thereof having been released by the owners of said land traversed by the drain or otherwise acquired;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jennifer L. Escott, County Drain Commissioner, do order and determine that the drain shall be and is hereby established in accordance with the above-described survey and that the commencement, route, terminus, length, depth and width of surface excavations of the drain shall, in every respect, be in accordance therewith.
