I. Consent Agenda

- A. Approve Minutes:** No comments were made on June meeting minutes
- B. Finance Report:** The finance report was available.
- C. Reports:** Monthly reports of the Waste Hauler Tonnage Logs, County-wide Recycling, and Recycling Drop Off Site were available.

Motion by G. Elliott, seconded by J. Palmer, to approve the consent agenda. Motion carried.

II. Discussion Items

- A. Lenawee County Debris Management Plan:** Craig Tanis, Emergency Management Coordinator, reviewed the recently adopted Debris Management Plan. In conjunction with state and local agencies the plan was created to enhance emergency response capabilities.

The plan addresses policies, procedures, responsibilities and methods for dealing with debris generated by a disaster.

- B. Materials Management Planning Update:** A summary of the introduced legislation HB4453-4461 was submitted; this will be an amendment to Part 115. In April it passed in the House and was referred to the Senate.

A draft copy of County Solid Waste & Materials Management Planning 101 was distributed. This document is being prepared in order to answer some basic questions.

The Lenawee County Solid Waste Plan was adopted in 1997. An updated Plan was created in 2016, it was not approved by the required number of municipalities and was therefore submitted to the State for consideration. The updates to the solid waste plan have not been initiated and EGLE does not anticipate calling for a plan update until we know the outcome of the legislation currently in the Senate Regulatory Reform Committee.

C. Program Coordinator's Report: B. Borton reviewed the coordinator's report.

DOS Upgrade: There haven't been any issues at the drop off site; 32.66 ton of fibrous and 14.45 ton of rigids were collected.

2022 Tire Collection Date: A second tire collection is being scheduled for August 25th and it will be held at the Drop Off Site. The gate to the Drain Commission parking lot is going to be opened and people will be drive through to drop off their tires.

Outreach: Recycling inserts were shared for members to distribute. Becky will be talking to the Addison Women's Club in August to discuss recycling.

Other Collection Events:

- Ag Container Collection: 7/8, 7/29, 8/19, 9/16 flyer has been shared
- HHW Collection: tentative plans to hold one this fall

Adrian Landfill: MMD staff determined that the facility was found to be in compliance with operational requirements of Part 115 that were evaluated (report on file).

Administrative Calendar: An updated administrative calendar is attached.

- SWCCC Goals & Objectives – The Committee agreed that setting goals and objectives could wait until actions are taken in legislation.
