I. Community Mental Health Authority Board

Lenawee Community Mental Health Authority has an opening on its Board of Directors for a community minded person. A current or previous consumer of CMH services, including substance abuse disorder treatment is preferred. This is a three year term of office pending appointment by the County Board of Commissioners with per diem and mileage compensation. Availability one day per month for Board Meetings, and appointment to other committees as assigned. II. Department on Aging

The purpose of the Board shall be to promote and safeguard the independence and well-being of senior citizens in Lenawee County. The Board shall be appointed by the County Board of Commissioners. In recommending persons for appointment to the Board, consideration shall be given to those representing the needs of the Board, representation from senior citizens, from supporting organizations and governmental units, and from various community interests. The Board is seeking candidates to fill one District #5 Representative from the Eastside City of Adrian [Voting Precincts 1,2,and 3] and one District #8 Representative from the Eastside of Adrian Township [exc the city], and Raisin Township.

III. Economic Development Corporation

The corporation is organized with reference to Act 338 of the Public Acts of 1974, as amended, and its purposes will be to alleviate and prevent conditions of unemployment, to assist and retain local industries. The EDC is seeking candidates to fill one District #8 (Eastside of Adrian Township [exc the city], and Raisin Township), and one At-Large Representative.

IV. Homeland Security & Local Emergency Planning

The Committee shall discharge the responsibilities delegated to Local Emergency Planning Committees by the State of Michigan and by federal law, including but not limited to:

- Developing the Local Emergency Response Plan, as required.
- Providing for Community Right-To-Know procedures, as mandated.
- Overseeing the collection and storage of data required to implement these tasks.

Membership on the Committee shall be recommended by the Lenawee County Board of Commissioners for appointment by the Michigan Emergency Planning and Community Right-To-Know Commission in consistency with state and federal requirements. The Committee is seeking candidates to fill one Local Chemical Facility Representative and one Mass Care Services Representative seat.

V. Region 2 Area Agency on Aging

The Committee is seeking those interested in improving conditions affecting the lives of older adults and individuals with disabilities. Providing advocacy, information, planning, program development, contracting and the funding necessary for program and service development.
