

**Have there been  
any COVID-19 vaccine  
safety concerns?**



On April 23, 2021, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) announced that administration of the Johnson & Johnson/Janssen (J&J) COVID-19 vaccine can resume.

So far, none of the original vaccine trials have reported any serious safety concerns. Trials for the vaccines have had fully independent safety monitoring boards, and safety data are continuously reviewed by the FDA and expert panels. The number of serious problems in test participants was very low, and there was little difference between those who received the actual vaccine and those who received a placebo.
