Michigan Saves Lead Poisoning Prevention Fund

Michigan Saves created the Lead Poisoning Prevention Fund (Lead Fund) to fill a critical gap for homeowners and income property owners who don't qualify for free Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) lead abatement services. We're working to make sure everyone—no exceptions—has peace of mind when it comes to the safety of their homes.

THE PROCESS

STEP 1: Customer intake

- Customers submit applications through MDHHS
- MDHHS screens the application for free lead abatement services
- Denied applicants are referred to the Lead Fund

STEP 2: Environmental investigation

- Required for all projects
- MDHHS will cover the cost of the environmental investigation if:
 - The application is screened by central intake
 - The customer signs a commitment form

STEP 3: Workscope development

- Contractor develops the workscope based on:
 - The priority of the lead hazards identified in the environmental investigation
 - The amount of financing available to the customer

STEP 4: Loan application

Applying for a Michigan Saves loan is easy, so you can get started on removing lead from your home right away. A Michigan Saves authorized contractor will walk you through the process.
